



### Purpose

The overarching purpose of the National Snowsport Facilities Group is to deliver the facilities strategy and reacting to any facility issues within England.

The Group will deal with the following :

- Planning queries
- Advice on the refurbishment and development of facilities
- General advice for Facility managers
- Support for sites at risk
- Developing evidence
- Implementation of the strategy

### Action Plan

The Group will produce an Action Plan annually and update the facility strategy as required.

### Position within Snowsport England Governance

*The National Snowsport Facilities Group will report directly to the Snowsport England board and will be in charge of the delivery of the facility strategy. It will link with the necessary discipline committees as and when needed.*

### Membership

The Group shall comprise of the Chair and people with the following skills:

- Facility Management and/or operation
- Facility Development
- Planning
- Sports Development
- Different snowsport disciplines
- Clubs

They will be supported by:

- Sport England facilities relationship manager
- Snowsport England Development officer

Nominations for membership of the Group shall be made to the Chair who may require supporting information before reaching a decision.

The tenure of members of the Group may be altered at the discretion of the Chair to meet the purpose required of the Group.

### Intellectual property

Output produced by the Group will become the intellectual property of Snowsport England and shall not be reproduced without the prior written consent of the Chief Executive.

**The National Facilities group will meet a minimum of 3 times per annum**
