	<i>After discussion the Summer Race Calendar 2008 was finalised, the ERSA Championships will be held at WGC on Sun 5th Oct. ERSA RTP to organise helped by clubs. There have been a number of clashes and by tradition these are mainly with the Celtic Cups. The Tri Regions event, this year organised by ERSA will be held on Saturday 4th October at BWP, ERSA to provide medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd in the team and plate event.</i>	
02.00.08	Race Format, Changes and Information	ALL
	<i>The actual race format would stay the same with 2 runs to count out of 3. Start order as previous years using ERSA points. Entry criteria as previous years. Pre registration has worked well and will continue in the same format. This will make it easier for the organisers on Sunday morning. Any late entries after 1200h on the Saturday before the race will be given the highest bib numbers and race first regardless of seed points. Entries will still be accepted Sunday morning. However the race office for registration WILL close at 0900h (30 minutes earlier than 2007), after this time the race will be closed. Slight variation in the timetable affecting open practice (close at 0915h) and course setting, see invites for details. The idea being behind these changes is to try and speed up the day.</i> <i>For the 1st race (Hemel SL at Welwyn) it was requested that names be given by 1200h on the Friday before the event. This is because of the Hemel CN being held on the Saturday.</i>

02.02.08	<i>Fee to remain at £9.00 with £6.00 going to the centres, £3.00 to ERSA. Family discount applies.</i>	
02.03.08	<i>Course Inspection, the actual method of course inspection will be decided by the jury on the day The order of course inspection will change with JN2 and older going first followed by CH2 and below. It was felt this would make the inspection and racing easier for the less experienced younger racers.</i>	
02.04.08	<i>Championships, same entry criteria as 2007, however a seed point cut of may be applied to ensure suitability of racers to compete. This will be investigated towards the championship date.</i>	
02.05.08	<i>A reminder was given that it is the responsibility of the next club in the Summer season to arrange transfer of the timing equipment to their slope. Any breakages should be reported so repairs can be carried out.</i>	
02.06.08	<i>Course setters, it was agreed to try and use various course setters from within the region, however those people racing in "competitive" groups would not be used unless other setters were not available. The list will be updated and a request was made that if members wish to appear on the list they should contact RTP.</i>	
02.07.08	<i>Request that race managers remind their club members of the need to wear helmets for all stages of the competition incl practice, course inspection and racing. Poles to have bungs, many racers from snow so timely reminder may be appropriate.</i>	
03.00.08	Summer League Dual Slalom Team Events	ALL
03.02.08	<i>It was felt that the ERSA racers were being disadvantaged when it came to National Relay events or the Tri Regions. It was decided to make the OPEN A category a relay event, all other categories remaining as head to head. Discussion took place if an OPEN B category should be run, it was decided to continue with the B team but to ensure that B teams were filled before the Rainbows. If a club only enters one OPEN team they will be in A. This arrangement will be reviewed after the 2nd race (Welwyn).</i>	

03.03.08	<i>The RAINBOW EVENT to continue in present format except that the event will be held before the main team event. By the end of the second run race managers will pass the names of ALL racers that wish to take part in the "Rainbow" event.</i>
