Bassingbourn Ski Slope is located on Ministry of Defense property. Please respect their rules. All vehicles must adhere to a speed limit of 15 mph. No smoking allowed on site. No BBQ's on site.

Directions

Access to the centre is via the North Gate of Bassingbourn Barracks, which is approx 3/4 miles north on the A1198 of the main gate off the A1198. The postcode is SG8 5LX, which can be used on most map sites.
