Race Bulletin 2: Acceptance





Organisation

The race is being organised by Eastern Region Ski Association (ERSA) on behalf of Snowsport England. ERSA is pleased to acknowledge the generous sponsorship provided by Ski Solutions, Valle D'Aosta, Ski Bartlett and Atomic for the GP series and the support of The Snow Centre (Hemel Hempstead) and Hemel Ski Racing Club in the organisation of the event.

We would like to thank the management and staff of The Snow Centre, Hemel Hempstead, and all volunteers for their assistance, without which there would be not be a race.

Entry Criteria

The Grand Prix is a special slalom of 2 runs down 2 different courses and is open to registered competitors in the following categories: Children 1, Children 2, Junior 1, Junior 2, Seniors and Masters. Racers with lower seed points will be given priority; there will be a cut off of 300 seed points. The current BARTS seed list (2011.3) will be used.

For the first run the top 15 seeded competitors will be drawn for bibs 1 through 15 with competitors seeded 16 onwards running in ascending seed point order.

For the second run the top 15 will run in reverse time order (i.e. 15^{th} fastest from 1^{st} run will run 1^{st} in 2^{nd} run, 14^{th} fastest will run 2^{nd} ... fastest from first run will run 15^{th} in second run) followed by competitors ranked 16^{th} onwards in ascending time order.

Competitors who do not finish or are disqualified in the 1^{st} run may be allowed a run in the second run on the female course after the completion of the female 2^{nd} run at the discretion of the competition jury.

Open Practice is the designated area on the main slope is included in the race entry fee. The 'side slope' is not to be used. Please keep your gear in the lockers provided or under the benches in the changing area.

Acceptance

At the Jury meeting held on Saturday 9th July 2011 entries from 107 competitors were received and considered for entry, 31 Females and 73 Males were accepted.

Entries from the following racers have been provisionally accepted due to failure to meet the 300 seed point cut off limit based on BARTS Seed List 2011.3.

However, it is understood that the racers listed above have competed in races since the current seed list was issued and/or are competing in the Club National at Hemel Snow Centre (Saturday 16th July) and if successful in achieving the required seed points may ask for their entries for this event to be accepted subject to the agreement of the National Seeder. Any competitor who is not successful in gaining entry to this race will have a full refund of the race entry fee.

As the race is not fully subscribed the Jury will consider late entries at £21 until 7pm on Wednesday 13th July. Any racer showing an 'Action' by their name MUST complete the discrepancy with the Race Secretary before their bib will be issued.

The start order for the 1st run will be drawn on Wednesday14th July using Snowsport England BARTS seed list 2010.3. This seed list may be found on www.gbski.com website. The start list will be published on www.britski.org website and emailed to entrants where an email address has been supplied.

Protests against Acceptance / Late Entries

Protests against non-acceptance must be received in writing by the Race Secretary by email or by first post on Thursday 14th July 2011

Regulations, Race Rules, Health and Safety

The race will be run under F.I.S. rules as varied by the SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) 2010. This manual is available on http://www.gbski.com/rules.php. Racers and race officials should also be aware of the Guide to the Rules of Ski Racing available on http://www.britski.org/racingguide08.pdf

The Jury has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time in the start. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS613.6. Start licences may be checked. TD's have been instructed to apply the un-sportsman like behaviour rule to any competitor using bad language.

Competitors are reminded of the regulations governing the limits on ski/binding height. These regulations are liable to be enforced during this event.

Gloves and long sleeved garments must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

All competitors and forerunners MUST wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet on the slope throughout the event. This includes the practice session, course inspection and the race itself.

The jury has decided that all courses for this event will be set with single pole gates in accordance with BACR Book 1–801.2.6

The jury also decided an amendment to BACR Book 1—621.11.2, for the second run the top 15 will be reversed not the top 30.

Course Inspection

Access to the slope is for officials and racers only, no parents or coaches will be permitted onto the slope. Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection only, but must be on skis or snow blades. Race trainers/coaches who accompany their racers must be qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race. This form is available for download from http://www.gbski.com/docstore/forms/Accreditation Form UK.doc No other people will be allowed to enter the race area.

- Inspection on foot either by racers or coaches is not permissible
- In order to preserve the racing surface, course inspection may be varied. Please listen to instructions on method of course inspection.

Hemel Snow Centre Rules

- The training slope, to the right of the main slope will be out of bounds, there will be public lessons in progress on this slope at various times.
- Helmets must be worn by all athletes whilst on the slope and during open practice bibs MUST BE WORN so number is visible from back and front. Racers without a bib will be asked to leave the slope.
- Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection only. A Hi-Viz jacket must be worn.
- Racer assistants (e.g. coach or parent) will **NOT** be allowed in the Start Area because of the restricted size and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of arena.
- Only authorised people allowed in the snow arena, this includes any area of the snow through the airlock. These doors are not to be kept open.
- Due to Health and safety regulations no skis in the bar area unless in a ski bag, boots may be worn anywhere within the centre. Please be careful. There is a ski rack at the top of the stairs just before entering the bar area.
- In the event of any emergency please listen to the PA system and follow the instructions of race officials or ski centre staff.

Ski Preparation

The Snow Centre will set up a Gazebo in the car park with tarpaulin on the floor for anyone needing to prep skis.

No ski prep is to take place in the building, including the boot room or in the car park except in the designated area.

Ski Storage

Please ensure that skis are stored in a safe manner. There are ski racks behind the netting but once these are full skiers will have to store their skis in the racks in the EDGE (bar upstairs) or back in their cars the Snow Centre cannot have skis in front of the fire exit on the slope. Lockers are provided in the changing area (refundable £1 deposit). Hemel Snow Centre accepts no responsibility for valuables or equipment left unattended. Skis are not to be left outside on the snow, the racks must be used.

First Aid

First aid cover will be provided by the Snow Centre.

Doping Control

Competitors should note that the Dope Control Unit may arrive unannounced at any event and will have the complete co-operation of the organisers of this race. Please ensure you are up to date with the latest regulations. Details may be found at http://www.britski.org/AD_antidoping.htm

Race Officials

Officials will also be required to wear a hi-viz jacket showing that you are an official; otherwise you will not be allowed to enter the slope. Officials should either be on skis or if you are located towards the bottom of the slope you may borrow snowboard boots to wear. No outdoor shoes are permitted on the slope.

Refreshments

The EDGE Café Bar is located on the top floor of the Snow Centre. The Edge bar and café will be open throughout the day. *No food or beverages may be bought into The Snow Centre. No BBQ's to be used in the car park.*

Breakfast (from 7.30)

Tea and coffee in take away cups served from station in entrance to the EDGE.

Squash served from station in entrance to the EDGE.

Full breakfast available.

Lunch

The Edge offers an extensive food and beverage menu.

Commentator Sheets and Race Bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the second run, failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib. The Finish Marshall will be located in the changing room by the exit from the snow. Competitors who do not qualify for the 2nd run should return their bib to the Race Office at the top of the stairs on the top floor of the Snow Centre.

Protocol /Referee's Report

Protests against the Referee's Report must be made on official forms, which will be available from the race Office. The form must be completed and returned to the Race Secretary within the published time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.

Practice Session

The Snow Centre have kindly agreed that racers who are competing in the Sunday ERSA GP event may practice at the Snow Centre on Saturday 16th July 2011 from 1800 to 2000 at a discounted rate of £12.50 for 1 hour or £25 for 2 hours; subject to availability. This offer is strictly limited to the GP competitors who appear on the start list. The Snow Centre will be open to the public at this time so **no high speed skiing** will be tolerated. Respect must be given to all other slope users and any instructions given by Snow Centre staff must be obeyed.
