





## Snow & Rock Hemel Club National 2011

Saturday 16th<sup>h</sup> July 2011

Race Bulletin: Acceptance

#### Organisation

The race is being organised by Hemel Ski race Club. Hemel are pleased to acknowledge the support of Snow + Rock and The Snow Centre (Hemel) and Hemel Ski Racing Club.

We would like to thank the management and staff of The Snow Centre, Hemel Hempstead, and all volunteers for their assistance, without which there would be not be a race.

#### Entry Criteria

The Club National is a special slalom of 2 runs down 2 different courses and is open to registered competitors in the following categories: Mini, Children 1, Children 2, Junior 1, Junior 2, Seniors and Masters. Racers with higher or no seed points will be given priority; there will be a maximum number of racers for this event.

For the first run the top 15 seeded competitors will be drawn with competitors seeded 16 onwards running in seed point order. The 2<sup>nd</sup> run will be reversed. Each run will be an event in itself and seeded separately but awards will be given for the combined times of both runs.

For the minis in the first run the girls will go first followed by the boys in bib order, in the 2nd run the order will be reversed as published in the attached start list.

Competitors who do not finish or are disqualified in the  $1^{st}$  run will be allowed to have a dsq/dnf run after on the Female course after their  $2^{nd}$  run.

#### Programme

The times given below are provisional and may alter on the day, but in order to meet the tight timescales please ensure you are ready to start on time and listen carefully for announcements.

Every effort will be made to keep to the above schedule; however the organisers reserve the right to amend the schedule as appropriate. Please listen carefully to commentators announcements.

Open Practice in the designated area on the main slope is included in the race entry fee. The "Side slope" is not to be used. Please keep gear stowed under benches in changing rooms as the public will be present.

#### Acceptance

At the Jury meeting held on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July the following entries were considered. Entries from 166 competitors were received and considered for entry, 36 Minis, 45 Females and 85 Males. All entries by the official closing date have been accepted. Late entries will be accepted up until Wednesday 13th July or until the race is "Full". Late entries will be given the higher bib numbers in the order received and compete last. The current BART's seed list (2011.3) will be used.

Any racer showing an "Action" by their name MUST complete the discrepancy with the race secretary before their bib will be issued.

The start order will be drawn on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July using Snowsport England BART's seed list 2011.3. This seed list may be found on <a href="https://www.gbski.com">www.gbski.com</a> website. The start list will be published on <a href="https://www.britski.org">www.britski.org</a> website and emailed to entrants if email address supplied..

#### Protests against Acceptance / Late Entries

Protests against non-acceptance must be received in writing by the Race Secretary by email or by first post on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2011. Late entries will not be accepted after the extended closing date. Results of protests may be obtained by telephoning the Race Secretary, Amanda Rolph on, 01442 865477 between 8pm and 9pm on Thursday, 14th July 2011.

#### Race Rules

The race will be run under F.I.S. rules as varied by the SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) 2010. This manual is available on http://www.gbski.com/rules.php.

Racers and race officials should also be aware of the Guide to the Rules of Ski Racing available on http://www.britski.org/racingquide08.pdf

The Jury has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time in the start. The Start Referee will be instructed to work to FIS613.6. Start licences may be checked. TD's have been instructed to apply the un-sportsman like behaviour rule to any competitor using bad language.

Competitors are reminded of the regulations governing the limits on ski/binding height. These regulations are liable to be enforced during this event.

Gloves and long sleeved garments must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

All competitors and forerunners MUST wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet on the slope throughout the event. This includes the practice session, course inspection and the race itself. Helmets should be compliant with standard BS EN 1077:1996 Specification for helmets for alpine skiers.

#### Course Inspection

Access to the slope is for officials and racers only, no parents or coaches will be permitted onto the slope. Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection only, but must be on skis or snow blades. Race trainers/coaches who accompany their racers must be qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race. This form is available for download from <a href="http://www.gbski.com/docstore/forms/Accreditation Form UK.doc">http://www.gbski.com/docstore/forms/Accreditation Form UK.doc</a> No other people will be allowed to enter the race area.

- Inspection on foot either by racers or coaches is not permissible
- In order to preserve the racing surface, course inspection may be varied. Please listen to instructions on method of course inspection.

#### Snow Centre Rules

- The training slope, to the right of the main slope will be out of bounds, there will be public lessons in progress on this slope at various times.
- Helmets must be worn by all athletes whilst on the slope and during open practice bibs MUST BE WORN so number is visible from back and front. Racers without a bib will be asked to leave the slope.
- Coaches may accompany their racers during course inspection only. A High Viz jacket must be worn.
- Racer assistants (e.g. coach or parent) will **NOT** be allowed in the Start Area because of the restricted size and the impact of overall numbers on the authorised fire capacity of arena.
- Only authorised people allowed in the snow arena, this includes any area of the snow through the airlock. These doors are not to be kept open.
- Due to Health and safety regulations no skis in the bar area unless in a ski bag, boots may be worn anywhere within the centre. Please be careful. There is a ski rack at the top of the stairs just before entering the bar area.
- Cat suits NOT recommended and not allowed for Boys and Girls (Mini's).
- In the event of any emergency please listen to the PA system and follow the instructions of race officials or ski centre staff.

#### Ski Storage

Please ensure that skis are stored in a safe manner. There are ski racks behind the netting but once these are full skiers will have to store their skis in the racks in the EDGE (bar upstairs) or back in their cars the Snow Centre cannot have skis in front of the fire exit on the slope. Lockers are provided in the changing area (refundable £1 deposit). Hemel Snow Centre accepts no responsibility for valuables or equipment left unattended. Skis are not to be left outside on the snow, the racks must be used.

#### Ski Preparation

The Snow Centre will set up a Gazebo in the Snow+Rock access road next to the centre with tarpaulin on the floor for anyone needing to prep skis.

No ski prep is to take place in the building, including the boot room or in the car park.

#### Doping Control

Competitors should note that the Dope Control Unit may arrive unannounced at any event and will have the complete co-operation of the organisers of this race. #### First Aid

First aid cover will be provided by the Snow Centre.

#### Race Officials

Officials will be required to wear a hi-viz jacket showing that you are an official and authorised to have access to the snow arena; otherwise you will not be allowed to enter the slope. Officials should either be on skis or if you are located towards the bottom of the slope you may borrow some snowboard boots to wear. No outdoor shoes are permitted on the slope.

Please comply with all instructions from the "Slope Patrol" or authorised persons.

#### Refreshments

The EDGE Café Bar is located on the top floor of the Snow Centre. For this race The Edge are laying on the following race menu. All food must be purchased from The Snow Centre, no food or beverages may be bought into The Snow Centre. No BBQ's to be used in the car park.

#### Notice Board

The official notice board will be located to the right of the reception desk in the changing area on the middle floor.

#### Commentator Sheets and Race Bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the second run, failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib. The Finish Marshall will be located in the changing room by the exit from the snow.

#### Protocol /Referee's Report

Protests against the Referee's Report must be made on official forms, which will be available from the race Office. The form must be completed and returned to the Race Secretary within the published time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.

#### **Practice Session**

No specific time or area has been provided by Hemel Snow Centre for practise on the Friday prior to the Club National event as this is "Freestyle Friday" evening with many jumps, rails and other features on the slope.

The Snow Centre have kindly agreed that racers who are competing in the Sunday ERSA GP event may practice at the Snow Centre on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2011 from 1800 to 2000 at a discounted rate of £12.50 for 1 hour or £25 for 2 hours; subject to availability. This offer is strictly limited to the GP competitors who appear on the start list. The Snow Centre will be open to the public at this time so no high speed skiing will be tolerated. Respect must be given to all other slope users and any instructions given by Snow Centre staff must be obeyed.


