Organisation

The race is being organised on behalf of Snowsport England by the Eastern Region Ski Association (ERSA) with the help of Norfolk Snowsports Club.

Entry Criteria

The Grand Prix is special slalom of 2 runs down two different courses and is open to registered racers in the following categories:

Children 1 Children 2 Junior 1 Junior 2

Seniors Masters

Racers with the lowest seed points will be given priority; there will be a cut-off of 300 seed points.

Entries from racers with more than the 300 seed point cut-off who are competing in the Norfolk CN race the day before will be provisionally accepted subject to the required seed points being gained in the CN races subject to the agreement of the National Seeder. Any competitor that wishes to enter the GP must have submitted their entry by the cut-off date. Any competitor who fails to gain the required seed points from the CN race will receive a refund of the race entry fee.

The top 15 racers will be drawn in 2 groups, the top 7 drawn in one group followed by the next 8 drawn in a second group and racers seeded 16 onwards will be run in seedpoint order

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times, but the organisers reserve the right to change the times if necessary. Please check the Race Notice Board on arrival and listen out for announcements over the P.A. system.

Race Rules

The race will be run under F.I.S. rules as varied by the SSE and published in the British Artificial Competition Rules (BACR) 2010. This manual is available on http://www.gbski.com/rules.php. Racers and race officials should also be aware of the Guide to the Rules of Ski Racing available on http://www.britski.org/racingguide10.pdf

Gloves and long sleeved garments which also cover the midriff must be worn at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice, course inspection and the race itself.

All competitors MUST wear a properly fitted and approved safety helmet on the slope throughout the event; this includes practice session, course inspection, fore runners, and the race itself. Helmets should be compliant with standard BS EN 1077:1996 Specification for helmets for alpine skiers).

It should be noted by all competitors that the use of 'Yellow 77' lubricant is <u>not</u> permitted at Norfolk Snowsports Club.

Race Format

The race will be run to the following format:

The first run will be held in reverse bib order. The second and final run will be in reverse time order based on the time from the first run and both must be completed. Each run will be on a different course.

Course Inspection

The course must be inspected wearing skis (or properly leashed snowblades), and bibs must be worn **correctly** throughout course inspection so that the bib is clearly visible from **both** front and rear. Noracer is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Course inspection may start from any point on the course and racers must come to a complete stop between each gate when inspecting. The first 10 minutes of course inspection will be for females, the next 10 minutes will be for all racers, and the last 10 minutes for males.

Only Accredited Race Trainers/Coaches will be permitted to accompany their racers on the course during inspection.

Race trainers/coaches may accompany their racers provided they are qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race. No other people will be allowed to enter the race area. An Accreditation Form is available for download from http://www.britski.org/Coaches2009.pdf This must be completed and submitted to the Race Office prior to the end of open practice on the day of the race. Approved accreditations will be available from the Race Office before course inspection.

All prize winners are expected to show courtesy to the organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

Doping Control

Competitors should note that the Dope Control Unit may arrive unannounced at any event and will have the complete co-operation of the organisers of this race.

Acceptance

Minutes of the first jury meeting on 23rd April record that entries from **108** racers (**38** females and **70** males) had been received by the closing date for entry. All entries were accepted subject to their seed points being 300 points or less on BARTS Seed List 2011.0 or where the National Seeder has confirmed that racers have seed points below 300 based upon recent results.

Entries from racers with more than the 300 seed point cut-off and who competed in earlier races and/or are competing in the Norfolk Club National Race the day before, have been provisionally accepted subject to the required seed points being gained in the CN races subject to the agreement of the National Seeder. Any competitor that wishes to enter the Grand Prix must submit their entry by the cut-off date. Any competitor who fails to gain the required seed points from the CN race will receive a refund of the race entry fee.

Entries from racers with a note by their name on the enclosed acceptance list were provisionally accepted and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows:

R requires proof of registration

F requires the entry form to be signed/amended

P requires payment / payment adjustment of the race entry fee/sign cheque

S where BARTS points have been calculated and converted from BASS points and these are used for start list placing only

O other action required

The start order will be drawn on Wednesday 28th April at Norfolk Snowsports Club using Snowsport England BARTS Seed List 2010.0 This seed list can be found on the web site www.britski.org.uk. The start draw will also be published on the ERSA website at http://www.erskia.co.uk/racing/ERSAGP CN/ERSAGP CN 2010.htm

The top 15 racers will be drawn in 2 groups, the top 7 drawn in one group followed by the next 8 drawn in a second group and racers seeded 16 onwards will be run in seedpoint order

Non-Acceptance

In addition to the accepted entries, entries from the following racers have been provisionally accepted due to failure to meet the 300 seed point cut off limit based on BARTS Seed List 2011.0.

However, it is understood that the racers listed above have competed in previous races this season and/or are competing in the Club National at Norfolk (Saturday 30th April) and if successful in achieving the required seed points may ask for their entries for these races to be accepted subject to the agreement of the National Seeder. Any competitor who is not successful in gaining entry to this race will have a refund of the race entry fee.

Late Entries

The Jury will consider late entries (up to a maximum of 180 racers) received by **1800 Hrs on Wednesday 27**th **April 2011**. All late entries accepted will be drawn for start order, and will be placed on the start list to run before the entries already accepted, in the order they are received.

As the race is undersubscribed at the original closing date, late entries accepted will NOT be subject to an additional fee of £10.00.

Protests against Acceptance / Late Entries

Protests against non-acceptance must be received in writing by the Race Secretary by first post **Wednesday 27**th **April 2011.**

Results of protests and confirmation of acceptance of late entries may be obtained by telephoning the Race Secretary, Debs Ives, on 07901 717731 between 8.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m. on Wednesday 27th April 2011.

Race Office

The Race Office will be at the Race Secretary's address until the evening of Friday 29th April 2011. It will be located in the Norfolk Snowsports Club Building from 8.30 a.m. on Race Day.

Notice Board

The official race notice board will be located in the changing room adjacent to Reception.

Commentator Sheets and Race Bibs

Commentator sheets must be completed and handed in when collecting a race bib. Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the second run, failure to do so will result in a charge of £25.00 for each missing bib.

Referee's Report Protests

Referee's Report protests must be made on official forms which will be available at the Race Office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.00.

Refunds

Once accepted into the race, refunds will only be given to racers if a request is supported by written medical evidence.

Photography

Racer Ready will be the photographer for the race and is accredited by the organisers. No other photographers will be permitted on the slope without prior accreditation by the organisers.

Racers who entered using the online system have had the opportunity to opt out of having their photographs taken by an accredited photographer. Any other racer who wishes to opt out must inform the Race Secretary prior to the day of the race.

Open Practice

After the Club National Race on the 30th April, the bar will remain open and the ski slope will be available for skiing (£7.50 fee), 6.00 p.m. to 8.00 p.m. Tubing sessions may also be booked on the intermediate slope

Refreshments/Entertainment

There will be food and drink available for sale throughout the event either from the bar or from the Barbeque.

First Aid

Qualified First Aid personnel will be in attendance at the race.

Ski Hire
