Organisation

The event is being organised by WGC Ski Race Club with the assistance of ERSA on behalf of Snowsport England.

Entry Criteria

The Club National is a special slalom of 3 runs down the same course, and is open to register and non registered racers in the following categories:

Minis Girls, Minis Boys, Children I, Children II, Junior I, Junior II, Senior, Masters.

Racers with no seed points are given priority over those with seed points and unregistered racers in the event of the race being oversubscribed. The Minis' race follows the same format, and is open to registered racers born in 2001 > 2004

Every attempt will be made to keep to the stated times but the organisers reserve the right to change the timetable equally there may be the opportunity to shorten the day when possible.

Please check the Race Notice Board on arrival and listen out for announcements over the P.A. system.

Race Rules/Health and Safety

The race will be run in accordance to BACR 2010(British Artificial Competition Rules) and under FIS rules as varied by Snowsport England. This manual is available on <http://www.gbski.com/rules.php> . Racers and race officials should also be aware of the Guide to the Rules of Ski Racing available on <http://www.britski.org/racingguide10.pdf>.

Racers & Parents to be aware of the following

1. The use of 'Yellow 77' lubricant is **NOT** permitted nor is **solvent based products**.
2. **Ski poles** - with a tip diameter of less than 15mm must be fitted with suitable tip protectors to increase the tip diameter to 15mm.

3. **Bad Language** – TDs have been instructed to apply the unsportsmanlike behaviour rule to any racer using bad language. This will result in sanctions ultimately leading to bans for repeated offenders.
4. **Helmets** - must now be worn by **ALL** competitors **AND** forerunners at **ALL** times while out on the slope and comply with revised regulations as published on www.britski.org or www.gbski.com
5. **Start licences** may be checked
6. **Dope testing** may take place at this event and may arrive unannounced at any event and will receive the complete cooperation of the organisers of this race.
7. **Only** accredited persons are permitted on the race area during the race.
8. **The Start Referee** has the right to refuse a racer starting if the racer does not appear on time.
9. **Racers will** be required to wear a helmet, gloves, long trousers and a long sleeved garment, which also covers the midriff to reduce the risk of injury, at all times whilst on the slope, including during open practice and course inspection during the race.
10. **No ski preparation/spraying** is to take place within the start area.
11. The course will be set using "Single "Slalom poles.

Race format

The race will be run to the following format.

The first and second runs will be held in reverse bib order and the better of these two times will count towards the final total. The third and final run will be in reverse time order based upon the best time from the first two runs and must be completed, i.e. the result will be based on the best time from the first two runs plus the time from the third. All runs will be down the same course.

Course Inspection

The course **must be** inspected wearing skis (or properly leashed snowblades) and bibs must be worn correctly throughout inspection so that the bib is clearly visible from **both** front and rear.

No racer is allowed to ski the course during inspection. Course inspection may start from any point on the course and racers must come to a complete stop between each gate when inspecting. The first ten minutes of course inspection will be for Minis Girls/Boys and Females, the next 10 minutes will be for all racers and the Last 10 minutes for males.

Only Accredited Race trainers/Coaches may accompany their racers on the course during inspection.

Race trainer/coaches may accompany their racers provided they are qualified and carry the relevant accreditation issued by the race office on the day or prior to the race. Masters racers please note that they are not eligible for prizes in the senior age group. For the purposes of Club National races, Seniors and Masters are designated as separate age groups.

Are prize winners are asked to show courtesy to the race organisers by attending the prize giving. Those who do not attend without good reason lose their claim to an award.

Acceptance

Minutes of the first Jury Meeting held on **30th April** recorded that entries from 88 racers (30 females, and 45 males) were received by the closing date for the Club National race and for the Minis Race (5 girls and 8 boys). All entries are accepted.

Entries from racers with a note by their names on the enclosed acceptance list were provisionally accepted and must see the Race Secretary on race day to validate their entry prior to collecting their bib. Notes are as follows.

R requires proof of registration

F requires the entry form to be signed/amended

P requires payment / payment adjustment of the race entry fee/ sign cheque

O other action required

The start order will be drawn on Thursday **5th May 2011** at WGC SRC using Snowsport England BARTS seed list 2011.0

This seed list can be found on the web site www.britski.org.

The start draw will also be published on the ERSA web site at www.ersa.co.uk

The top 15 females and 15 males will be drawn for start position, with the remaining seeded racers placed in reverse seed point order. Those without seed points will be drawn for start position to run before those with seed points.

An Acceptance List is attached to this bulletin.

****Late Entries****

The jury will consider late entries (up to a maximum of 180 racers) received by 1800 hrs on **Wednesday 4th May 2011**. All late entries accepted will be drawn for the start order, and will be placed on the start list to run before the entries already accepted in the order they are received.

As the race was undersubscribed at the original closing date, late entries accepted will NOT be subject to an additional fee of £10.00.

Protest against Acceptance / Late Entries

Protests against non-acceptance must be received in writing by the race secretary by the first post Wednesday 4th May 2011.

Race Office

The Race Office will be at the Race Secretary's address until the evening of **Friday 6th May 2011**. It will be located in the Race Officials Marquee located at the base of the ski slope from 8:15 am on Race Day.

Commentator Sheets and Race Bibs

Commentator sheets to be completed and handed in on collection of a race bib.

Race bibs must be returned to the Finish Marshall on completion of the final run, and failure to do so will result in a charge of £25 for each missing bib.

Referee's Report Protests

Referee's Report protests must be made on official forms which will be available at the Race Office. These must be completed and handed in within the set time limit and accompanied by a fee of £25.00.

Refunds

Once accepted into the race, refunds will only be given to racers if a request is supported by written medical evidence.

Photography

Only accredited photographers will be allowed on the race slope.

Racers who do not wish to be photographed by any accredited photographer must notify the race secretary in writing by the end of racer registration on the day of the race.

Open practice

Friday even on the WGC slope will be '**Open Practice Night**' with Poles (£11.00 fee for the 2 hr session) 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm.

Refreshments

WGC SRC will be running a BBQ on race day, but for Health & Safety reasons no other portable cookers are allowed on the patio, viewing area or grassed picnic areas.

First Aid

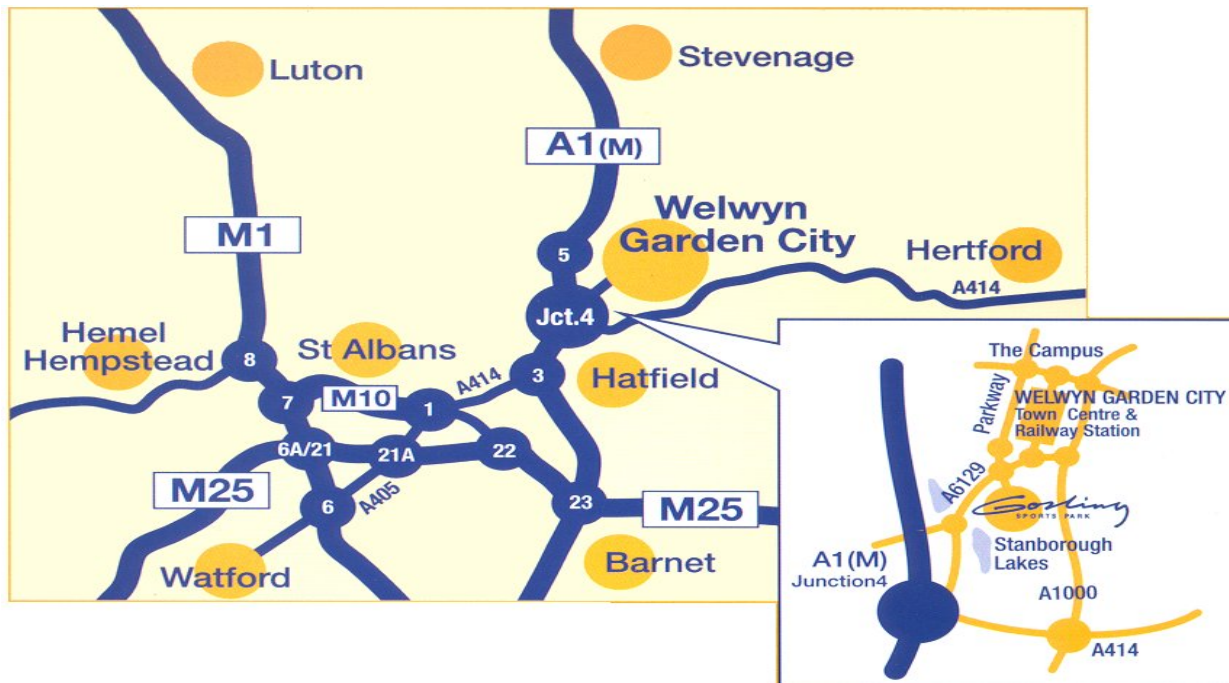
Gosling Ski & Board Centre will provide qualified First Aid personnel during race day.
