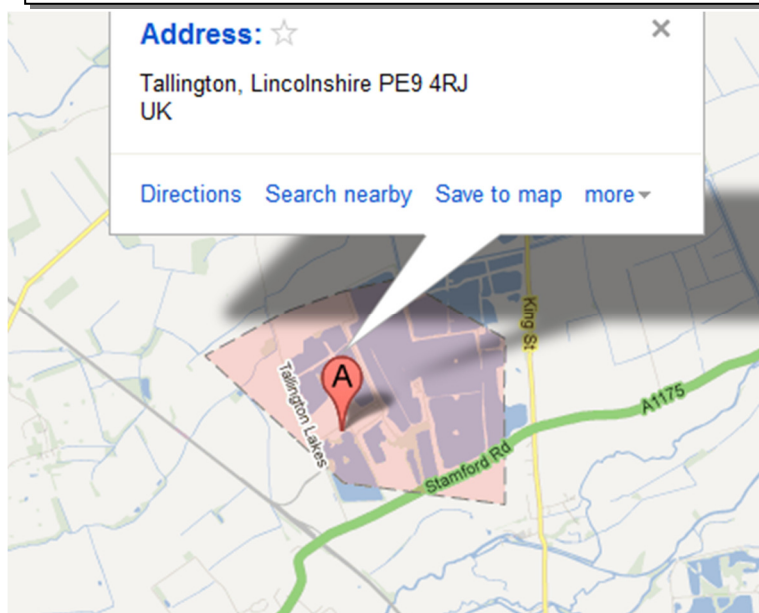
All 1st, 2nd, 3rd age group winners (M&F) receive a medal.

How to find Tallington Lakes, use SAT NAV PE9 4RJ.

Directions from the A1

Start out at the A1/A43 Junction, Cambs

Follow signs to Stamford A43

Wothorpe

Junction with Old Great North Road (B1081)

At T-junction turn left (signposted Town Centre)

Stamford Town Bridge

At traffic signals forward to cross River Welland then at next traffic signals turn right A16 (signposted Spalding)

Junction for Bourne/Sleaford

Junction with Uffington Road

At roundabout take 3rd exit A16

Through Uffington village

Through Tallington village, over level crossing (you'll probably get stuck for a few minutes!)

Turn left on to Barholm Road

800m down turn right.

Finish at PE9 4RJ, Tallington Lakes.
